



FOOD DISTRIBUTION (IN LBS)



In 2020, the Food Bank of Northeast Arkansas was able to distribute 10.3 million pounds of food to those in need in Northeast Arkansas. For every \$1 raised, the Food Bank is able to help provide up to 4 meals. The Food Bank of Northeast Arkansas relies on volunteers throughout the year to pack food boxes and sort food donations. Without volunteers, Food Bank staff wouldn't be able to keep up with the demand. In 2020, the Food Bank had 1,274 volunteers who donated 2,982 hours.
