The Food Bank of Northeast Arkansas distributes food to 140 partner agencies & programs throughout 12 counties.




The Food Bank of Northeast Arkansas serves 17 senior centers in 12 counties. 1 in 5 seniors in NEA are at risk of hunger.



The Food Bank of Northeast Arkansas' Fresh Produce Program provides healthy fruits and vegetables to people facing hunger.

The Food Bank of Northeast Arkansas distributes 1,027 backpacks each week of the school year. The cost of each backpack is \$4.71. Through mobile food pantries, the Food Bank of Northeast Arkansas provided USDA Commodity foods to 398,926 people in 2021.



FOOD DISTRIBUTION (IN LBS)



In 2021, the Food Bank of Northeast Arkansas was able to distribute 8.5 million pounds of food to those in need in Northeast Arkansas. For every \$1 raised, the Food Bank is able to help provide up to 4 meals.

The Food Bank of Northeast Arkansas relies on volunteers throughout the year to pack food boxes and sort food donations. Without volunteers. Food Bank staff wouldn't be able to keep up with the demand. In 2021, the Food Bank had 1,362 volunteers who donated 5,012 hours.
