





FOOD DISTRIBUTION (IN LBS)



In 2022, the Food Bank of Northeast Arkansas was able to distribute **8.2 million pounds** of food to those in need in Northeast Arkansas. For every \$1 raised, the Food Bank can help provide **3.5 meals**. The Food Bank of Northeast Arkansas relies on volunteers throughout the year to pack food boxes and sort food donations. Without volunteers, Food Bank staff wouldn't be able to keep up with the demand. In 2022, the Food Bank had 1,831 volunteers who donated 6,034 hours.
