The Food Bank of Northeast Arkansas distributes more than 1,000 backpacks each week of the school year.



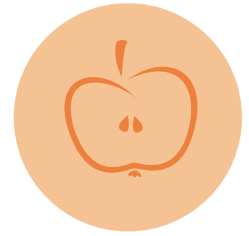
Sr. Food Pantry Network Program

Commodity Distribution Program

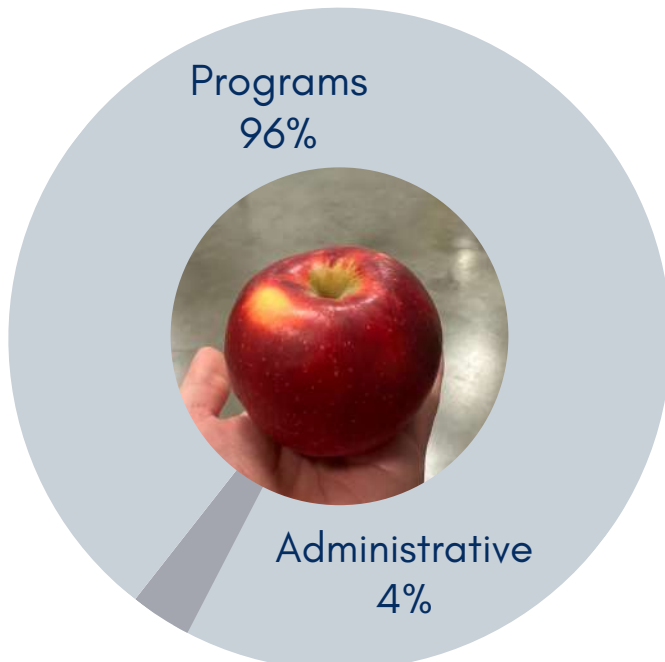
Through mobile food pantries, the Food Bank distributed 391,312 pounds of USDA Commodity foods in 2023.

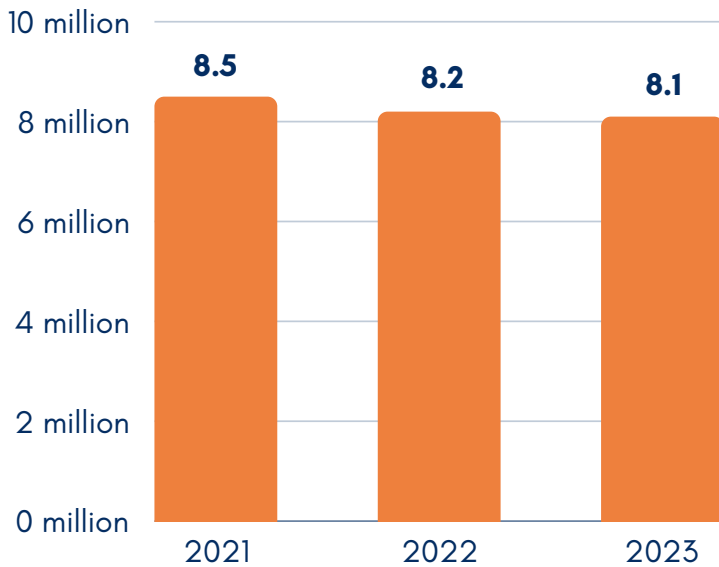

FOOD DISTRIBUTION (IN LBS)



In 2023, the Food Bank of Northeast Arkansas was able to distribute **8.1 million pounds** of food to those in need in Northeast Arkansas. For every \$1 raised, the Food Bank can help provide **3.5 meals**.

The Food Bank of Northeast Arkansas relies on volunteers throughout the year to pack food boxes and sort food donations. Without volunteers, Food Bank staff wouldn't be able to keep up with the demand. In 2023, the Food Bank had 1,828 volunteers who donated 5,711 hours.
